Job Description Summary:

Nature and Scope:

The Engineering Intern is an entry-level technical position in the Engineering Department of the Public Works Division reporting to the Engineering Manager. This position is expected to work with a moderate level of direction. This position has/will have contact with other City departments including the Street, Underground Utilities, Cemetery, Police, Fire, and Parks & Recreation Departments. The Engineering Intern may also have contact with Dayton Power & Light, the Ohio Department of Transportation, cable companies, telephone companies, the County Engineer's Office, contractors, consultants, realtors, suppliers, and the general public.

The major responsibilities of the Engineering Intern include: Assisting with the work of a survey crew during location and design surveys as well as boundary surveys. Preparing construction plans with CAD (Computer Assisted Design). Performing construction layout staking for capital improvement projects, and other projects of importance. Providing construction inspection/monitoring on capital improvement projects and private developments.

- ◆ Applicants must be currently enrolled (preferred) or planning to be enrolled as a student at a university with any of the following education majors:
