



# Sidney Curbside Recycling



Paperboard Boxes such as cereal, pasta, cake mix, rice, cracker & shoe boxes are **now** accepted at the curb with your other paper items. Please flatten the paperboard boxes, remove any plastic and place them in your Black Recycling Bin with your other paper items for recycling.

The City of Sidney curbside recycling is picked up the same day as your regular trash pickup. The following are the items that are accepted at the curb in Sidney and how they should be sorted.

## PAPER ONLY BLACK RECYCLING BIN or 2nd GREEN BIN



**Place** Newspapers, Magazines, Advertisements, Junk Mail, Copy Paper, Paperboard and Cardboard in the **Black Paper Only Recycling Bin or 2nd Green Bin.**



All papers should be placed loose in the paper only bin or put in brown paper bags. Do Not bundle or tie papers.



All cardboard and paperboard\* boxes must be flattened and cut down into pieces smaller than 2 feet X 2 feet.

\*Examples of paperboard includes cereal, cracker, cake & rice boxes.

**Please** remove all plastic wraps & bags  
NO Wet papers/boxes will be accepted.  
NO Boxes with Food Residue  
(Such as pizza boxes with grease or cheese).

On RAINY/WINDY Days,  
Paper/Cardboard should be placed in plastic grocery bags and tied shut.

## CO-MINGLED

(Plastic Bottles/Jugs, Steel/Aluminum Cans, Glass Bottles/Jars)

## GREEN RECYCLING BIN



**Place** Plastic Bottles & Jugs (#1 & #2 Only), Glass Bottles & Jars, Aluminum Cans and Steel Food Cans in the **Green Recycling Bin.**



**Please** remove all lids & rinse thoroughly.



PLASTIC Bottles & Jugs include milk jugs, beverage bottles, shampoo bottles, laundry jugs, and household cleaning bottles. **Only** plastic bottles and jugs



GLASS Bottles & Jars include clear, green and brown glass food or beverage



ALUMINUM Cans include food & beverage containers and pet food cans.



STEEL Cans include bi-metal (tin/steel) food, soup, coffee and pet food cans.

## ⊘ Examples of Unacceptable Items ⊘

Automotive product containers, plastic containers #3 to #7, bowls, buckets, tubs, bags, flower pots, microwave trays, fast food trays, Styrofoam, toys, mirrors, ceramics, light bulbs, window glass, drinking glasses, dishes, china, ceramics, paint cans, pots, pans, hangers, medical needles, diapers, batteries or appliances.

**PLEASE NOTE:** We reserve the right to refuse any unacceptable items. The Curbside Recycling Program is for Residential Recycling Only.
