

Household Hazardous Waste Collection Changes for Sidney and Shelby County Residents

Beginning in 2011, the North Central Ohio Solid Waste District will no longer offer the annual household hazardous waste collection day at the City of Sidney Service Center. Instead, the District will introduce a new program for residents to properly dispose of their household hazardous waste. Effective April 11, 2011, residents can call 1-800-553-6763 to schedule a time to drop off their household hazardous waste items at the Shelby County Recycling Center, 1600 Riverside Drive, Sidney. There will be a fee for the items brought in for disposal. Please watch for more details about the drop-off program in the newspaper and on the Solid Waste District's website at www.ncowaste.org.

Please Note: Household Hazardous Wasted Items may only be dropped off at the Shelby County Recycling Center *by appointment.* Anyone leaving items at the site other than at their appointed time may be prosecuted for illegal dumping per ORC 3767.32.

The City of Sidney will **NO** longer accept tires, oil, batteries, paint or other HHW items at the Sidney Service Center. These items may be disposed of as follows:

Proper Latex Paint Management



1. Be a wise consumer - Buy only what you need*.
*This will eliminate the need to store or dispose of leftover paint and it will save you money.
2. Use up left over paint on small projects, share with a neighbor or donate it to a local organization or charity.
3. Store paint properly by covering the opening with plastic wrap and securely seal the lid.

Disposing of Latex Paint

Latex paints can be dried and disposed of in the household trash, just follow these easy steps:

- In a well ventilated area remove the lid and discard.
- Add kitty litter, sand or oil dry to the paint to aid in the drying of the paint.
- After the paint is completely dry it can be discarded.
- Never pour paint on the ground or down a drain.**
