

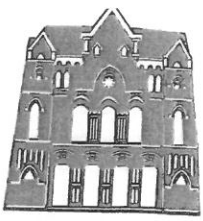

2016 ANNUAL REPORT (O.R.C. 1901.14A4)

Change was the name of the game for 2016 in the Sidney Municipal Court. The long awaited, often delayed Case Management software was deployed in October and the Court said a fond farewell to two employees in the Clerk of Court's office.

The first phase of the case management project was implemented in October and the change has been challenging but well received. One of the main upgrades of this system allows the Court records to be searched and viewed on-line. This feature permits anyone to not only see when their next court date and time may be, but also allows a person to view any documents filed within a case. Through this look-up citizens can search not only Municipal Court records, but also any public records filed in Common Pleas Court and Juvenile/Probate Court. Phase two of the project involves electronic payment of fines and costs through the case management system. While the Court currently accepts credit card payments on-line and at the counter, the payments must then be entered into the system by hand to credit the correct case. When implemented, the e-services functionality will allow a person to search for their ticket, find the correct amount to pay, enter their credit card information through a Pay-pal account or our host agency. Once the payment is processed the computer system will credit the correct case, close the case and complete the appropriate reporting for the BMV, and Supreme Court automatically. This will not only increase the efficiency of the Clerk's office, but also make the process much easier on the person paying their ticket. The Court hopes to have phase two up and running by the summer of 2018.

The third part of the project will be to implement Electronic filing of new cases and subsequent filings within those cases. The Court is expected to implement e-filing towards the end of 2018.




During 2016, 263 individuals entered the License Intervention Program. The Court had a 65% successful completion rate which resulted in another 171 valid properly insured drivers on the roads.

In 2016, \$2,255,282.44 was collected in receipts. In addition \$22,092.10 in Community Service was provided by offenders through the Court's Community Service Program.

The Court distributed \$21,761.81 in restitution to victims of crime and distributed garnishment monies in the amount of \$1,084,410.13 to creditors.

The Probation Department performed 428 drug tests, conducted 251 pre-sentence investigations and had 1,023 active probationers. The Bailiff's served 1,160 papers, transported 514 prisoners and the Court held video arraignment for 526 prisoners. More than 3,780 jail days were served by 162 defendants. In place of jail 367 people were placed in counseling and treatment programs. The Home Arrest program had 3,836 days served and saved \$211,000.00 in incarceration costs.

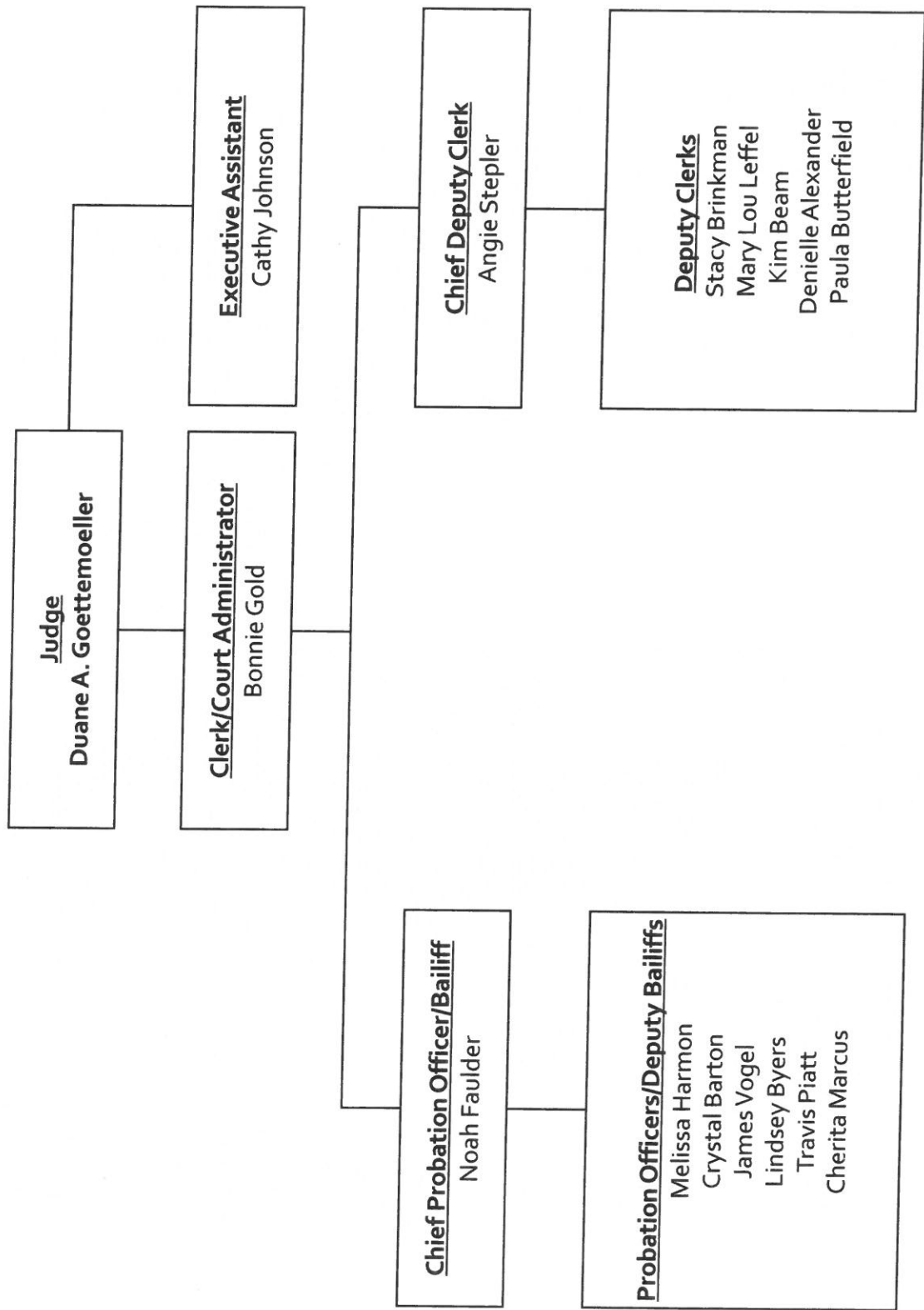

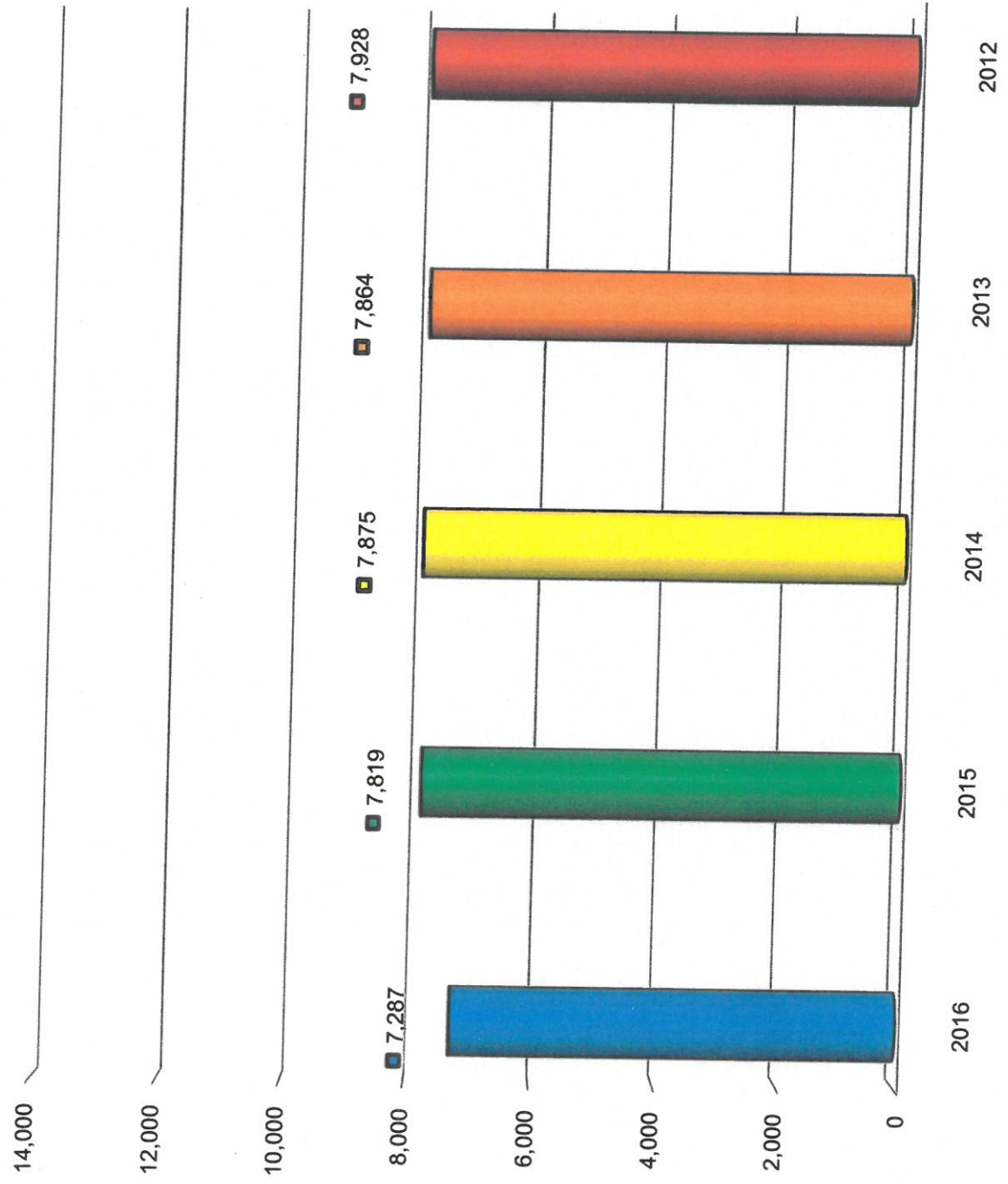

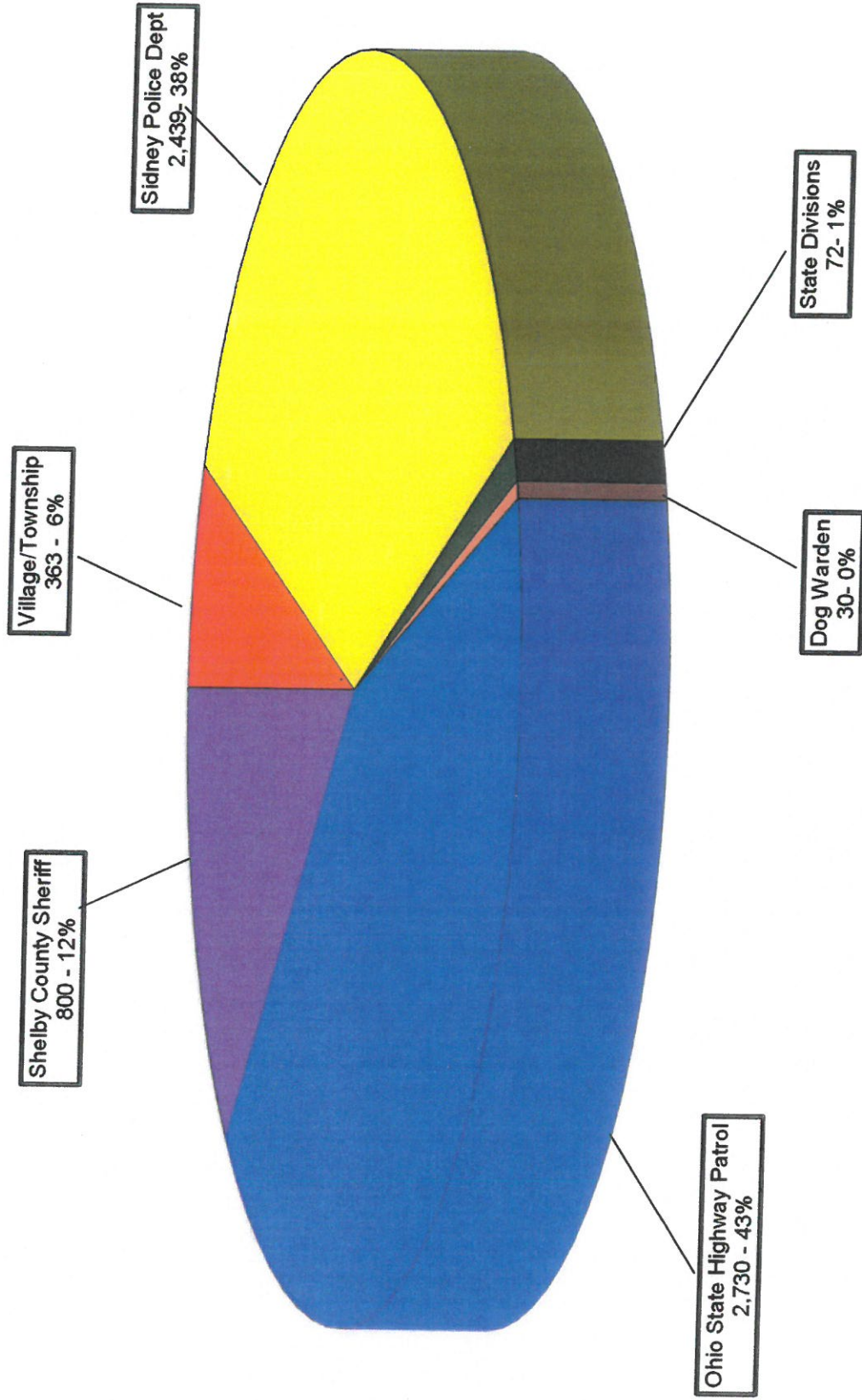

SIDNEY MUNICIPAL COURT 2016 CASE BREAKDOWN BY AGENCY



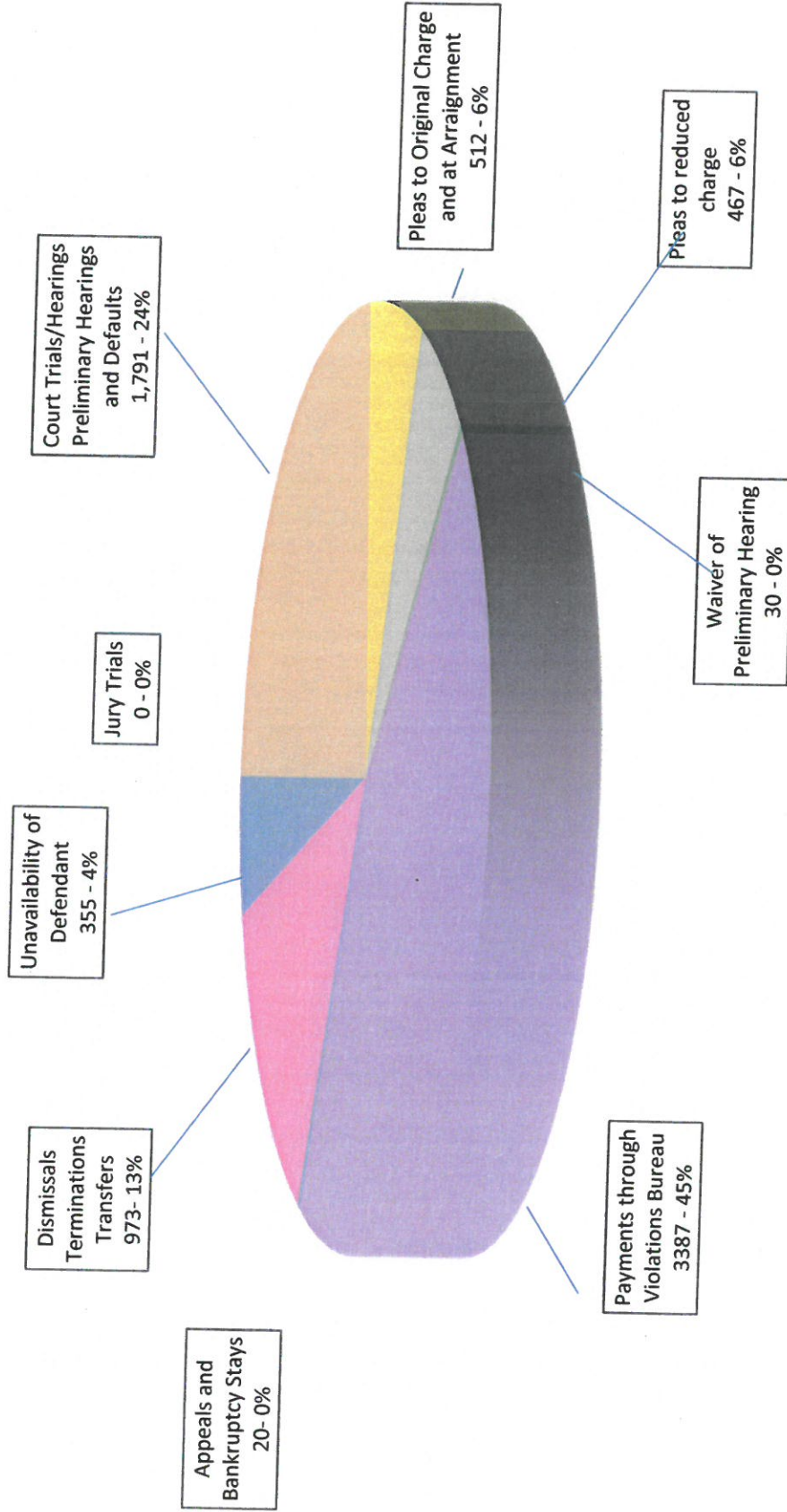
