Group Lessons

In order to provide the safest and healthiest environment possible, all group swim lessons currently require a parent in the water with each child registered for swim lessons. Parent/child groups will be spaced 6-feet apart in the water and instructors will teach from the pool deck. This requirement is based on the current mandate from the Ohio Department of Health to maintain a distance of at least 6 feet between people who don't live together.
